Execute deliverables across 4 federal cooperative agreements (PHEP/270, CRI/273, HPP/566, MRC-STTRONG/573) with 24/7 on-call availability for activations.

- **Steward the district's planning portfolio of 31 products** — 3 base plans (Emergency Operations Plan, Pandemic Response Plan, Mass Distribution Plan), 11 support annexes, 7 incident annexes, and 7 adopt-by-reference annexes — responsible for development, maintenance, SME coordination, and annual review against Georgia DPH templates aligned to CPG-101
- **Personally drafted 3 base plans and 10+ annexes to date** including the EOP, Mass Distribution Plan (synthesizing the state warehouse, dispensing, and mass vaccination streams into one district parent plan), COOP, Alert and Notification, EOC Activation, DHEART, Administrative Preparedness, Volunteer Management, Mass Fatality, and Pandemic Influenza annexes
- **Designed the district's planning information architecture** and planning suite crosswalk: a three-layer knowledge model in which programs own operational facts, plans consume validated knowledge, and exercises and AAR/IP corrective actions update it — replacing repeated SME data collection with a durable, turnover-resistant planning system
- **Support HSEEP exercise execution** as backup to the Training Coordinator role, contributing to 4 annual exercises and assisting with After-Action Report and Improvement Plan development within federal 60-day timelines
- **Facilitate annual hazard vulnerability analysis workshops** with county Emergency Management Agency partners using the Kaiser Permanente methodology to assess hazards and prioritize mitigation strategies feeding the planning suite
- **Design and deliver emergency management training** including WebEOC operations, ICS protocols, and just-in-time training for MRC volunteer deployments developed in coordination with the MRC Volunteer Coordinator; ensure completion of the annual 6-hour CBRNE training requirement for preparedness personnel

- **Provide WebEOC platform support and serve as primary district EOC contact** during real-world activations and county EMA-led events including tornado warning responses, coordinating information flow and inter-agency communications
- **Support the medical countermeasures program** through quarterly ReadyOp call-down drills, POD operations support, and MCM drill documentation in coordination with the MCM Coordinator
- **Conduct quarterly RadEye CBRNE equipment calibrations** (RADEYE-G, B20-ER) and maintain the emergency preparedness equipment inventory including emergency response vehicle, trailers, shelter supplies, and MCM materials
